NAMING OPPORTUNITIES

The Blue Hill Public Library's Endowment Campaign offers a variety of naming opportunities for major donors. Donor names will be listed on a plaque or as described below depending on the individual naming opportunity, and in keeping with the existing style established during the 2000 renovation. These naming gifts, and the recognition that comes with them, are essential to the campaign's success. Thank you for your consideration of the listed opportunities.

Main Entrance Foyer \$100,000 RESERVED

Located between the outside doors and the main room, donor names will be painted in gold on header of the double-doors leading into the room.

New Materials Kiosk \$25,000

A focal point of the main room, donor's name will be painted on a raised platform topped by a signature metal sculpture of an angel.

Artwork on Larchwood Room Desk \$25,000

Designed by artist and children's book illustrator Rebekah Raye, the desk will feature a bas relief, painted mural to complement the room's palette and style.

Bench in the Larchwood Room \$15,000 RESERVED

A heavily used area of the library, this bench is rarely without an occupant. A visible and important part of the facility.

Rowantrees Pottery Exhibit Case in Blue Hill Room \$15,000 RESERVED

Perfect for a donor interested in supporting local history. The case is inset in the surrounding bookcases featuring a well-lit permanent exhibit.

Children's Reading Area in Larchwood Room \$20,000 RESERVED

The location for much of children's programming as well as quiet reading by our youngest patrons and their families.

Benches in Wilder Room \$30,000 per bench

Built-in benches in an architectural style and prominent to both entrances, an outstanding feature of this beautiful reading room.

(2) Benches in Main Reading Room \$15,000 per bench (1) RESERVED

Generous, well-crafted built-in benches located on either side of the outside wall of the largest room in the library.

Fiction and Young Adult Loft, 2nd floor \$100,000

The donor's name will be painted on a prominent side of the loft to ensure maximum visibility.

Young Adult Librarian and Outreach \$250,000 RESERVED

A leadership gift funding an ongoing staff position with profound implications on the future of youth services focusing on young adult programming, collections and outreach. Donor's name will appear in both the YA section as well as on publicity and materials generated by this staff person. Prospectus available.

(2) Granite benches (\$10,000 per bench) (1) RESERVED

Using granite donated by a longstanding major donor to the library, exterior benches are available for placement on walkways leading to the library.

Artwork on Upper Wall between the Main Room and Circulation Area (TBD)

A well-positioned display location for a piece in or to be added to the permanent collection, the donor's name will appear on a plaque easily visible to patrons.

Lecture Series \$100,000 RESERVED

To complement the library's lecture programming, the donor's name will appear as underwriter in all signage and related publicity, denoting "The Donor's Name Lecture Series." This naming opportunity may be ongoing or a one-time series. To find out more please contact the library director.
